ORDER

SUBJECT: Mandating Indian Language Support for Mobile Phones as per IS 16333 (Part 3).

In exercise of the power conferred by clause 10(1)(p) of Bureau of Indian Standard Act, 1986 (63 of 1986) and in pursuance of clause (fa) of the rule 13 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Rules, 1987, the Central Government, hereby includes the Indian language support for mobile phone as per IS 16333 (Part-3) to the Schedule of "Electronics and Information Technology Goods (Requirement for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012".

2. The provisions of "Electronics and Information Technology Goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012" except paragraph 1(2), shall apply for the aforesaid inclusion by virtue of this Order w.e.f. 1st July 2017.
